INTRODUCTION

LOG Foundation is a registered public charitable trust which has been set up to support humanity, and for the purpose of undertaking charitable work throughout India, for social upliftment, alleviating human suffering, eradication of illiteracy and poverty, and for undertaking other philanthropic work. We desire to meet people in need at their place and share our resources plus encourage them to take steps towards restoring their life. We are registered under Sec 12 A of the Indian Income Tax Act and donations to us are exempted for Tax basis regulations under Sec 80G for AY 2022-23 to 2024-25.

Charity was a matter of emotions, convenience and sometimes recognition for a major part of our life. However it turned into a conviction when we experienced the Love of God in our lives. LOG Foundation is the structuring of our convictions so that we could make meaningful and visible impact possible in people's lives by standing with them in times of need. Sharing the beauty and hope in life with a purpose and intent to ones in need is our goal.





We are a grassroots level organization reaching out to the most marginalized and the vulnerable, children and families in society. The nature of the intervention and the means of delivery of services is adaptive - changing as per the context, circumstance, and need. Through our interventions we have tried to reach out to the people in need; children in orphanages, giving a ray of hope, supporting and helping the rag picking community of children with a holistic development focus, supporting single parents in bringing up children and support for their education, with building homes and shelters for the low-income group, medical aid for needy people even to the extent of building medical facilities where feasible.



We hope to continue to evolve benefitting more and more children and families in need and eventually leading to more empowered children growing up to be respected and responsible citizens of the country.

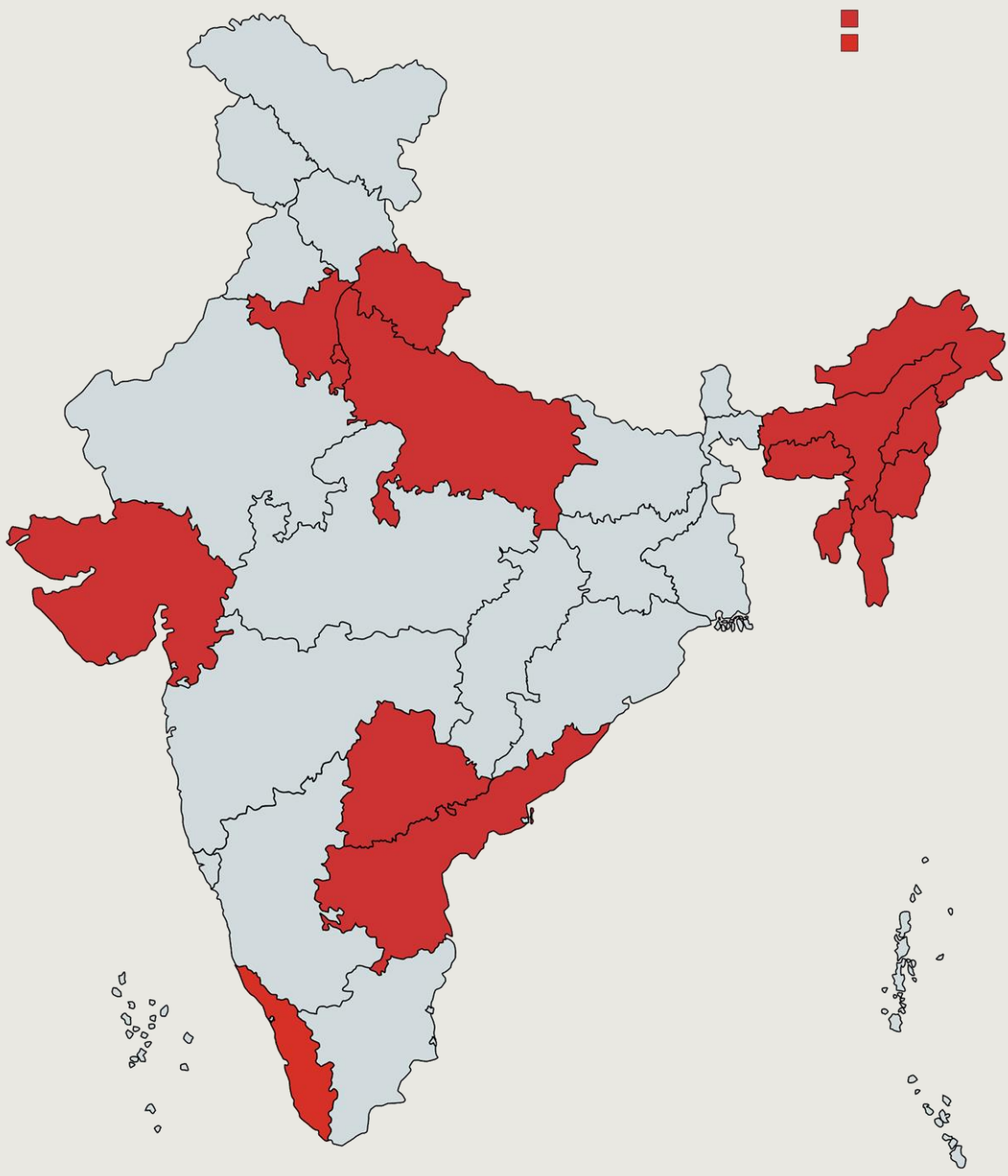

ACTIVITIES

LIFE SKILLS TRAINING

1. Log Foundation collaborated with LiveJam to conduct two one-day teacher training and student life skills and values session with 22 senior secondary school teachers + 10 Student Council members from Class 12 of St. Columba's School, New Delhi. They were given awareness training on the challenges faced by the teens of the day. Next, they were trained on the key principles of listening well. The second session was attended by 179 students and 22 senior secondary teachers and was instrumental in helping the students express themselves in the post-pandemic world about the issues that they faced and how to overcome them.



2. In another partner initiative of LiveJam, we were able to support their HereToHear project. The project envisages bringing awareness about issues of hopelessness, anxiety and fear. To support such troubled youths through a chat platform for hearing and responding to their cries for help on the website iamheretohear.org.

Housing Support



1. Mr. Vinayak Tandekar and his family used to live in a mud house that leaked during the rainy season and the resulting environment gave his family unending bouts of sickness and deprivation. We identified the problem and helped build his family a house, helping him come out of the endless cycle of ill-health.

2. A roof over the head is a luxury for many. We, in partnership with Udhaar Multipurpose Society, were able to partially support a poor family in building a small house so they could shift from their present mud dwelling



Child Welfare

1. In collaboration with Karuna Welfare, 50 children of an orphanage were gifted umbrellas and raincoats, to weather the hostile climate.
2. Shishya Campus hosts young boys from very poor and needy families to cater to their holistic development. We were able to partner with them for an evening of fun and frolic with 50 inmates

Humanitarian Support



1. We were able to provide 31 guards and gardeners with microwaves and room heaters to survive the harsh winters.



2. In another winter initiative, we partnered with Udhaar Multipurpose Society to provide warm winter clothing for a needy family.
3. We were also able to support an elderly retired teacher with their basic needs. The teacher returns the favour to society by giving free tuitions to poor children.



Ragpicker Community

1. Rag pickers and their families ring no bells for anybody. And yet their contribution to the society cannot be estimated. Log Foundation, in active partnership with Udhaar Multipurpose Society identified a ragpicker family and built a temporary shed as they had no roof over their head. The ragpicker himself was undergoing medical treatment.



2. The Ragpicker community has been a focus point of our activities since the beginning. We, in partnership with Udhaar Multipurpose Society, were able to support the initiative to buy a small piece of land for the educational needs of the ragpicker community children.



Medical Support



As part of our community care initiative, we were able to donate a physiotherapy machine for the help of paralytic patients. The machine was donated to a charitable hospital in Kerala which lacked funds for the machine.

Minority Support



ADF INTERNATIONAL

With a view to alleviate, in some measure, the oppression that the minorities are facing in the country, we partnered with ADF to provide free legal training to equip them to effectively liaison with the system.



Educational Support

1. Deepalaya is a renowned NGO intervening in Child Services with specific emphasis on education, and we were again privileged this year to join hands with them in sponsoring 3 of their children with educational support thus ensuring their holistic development and a brighter future.



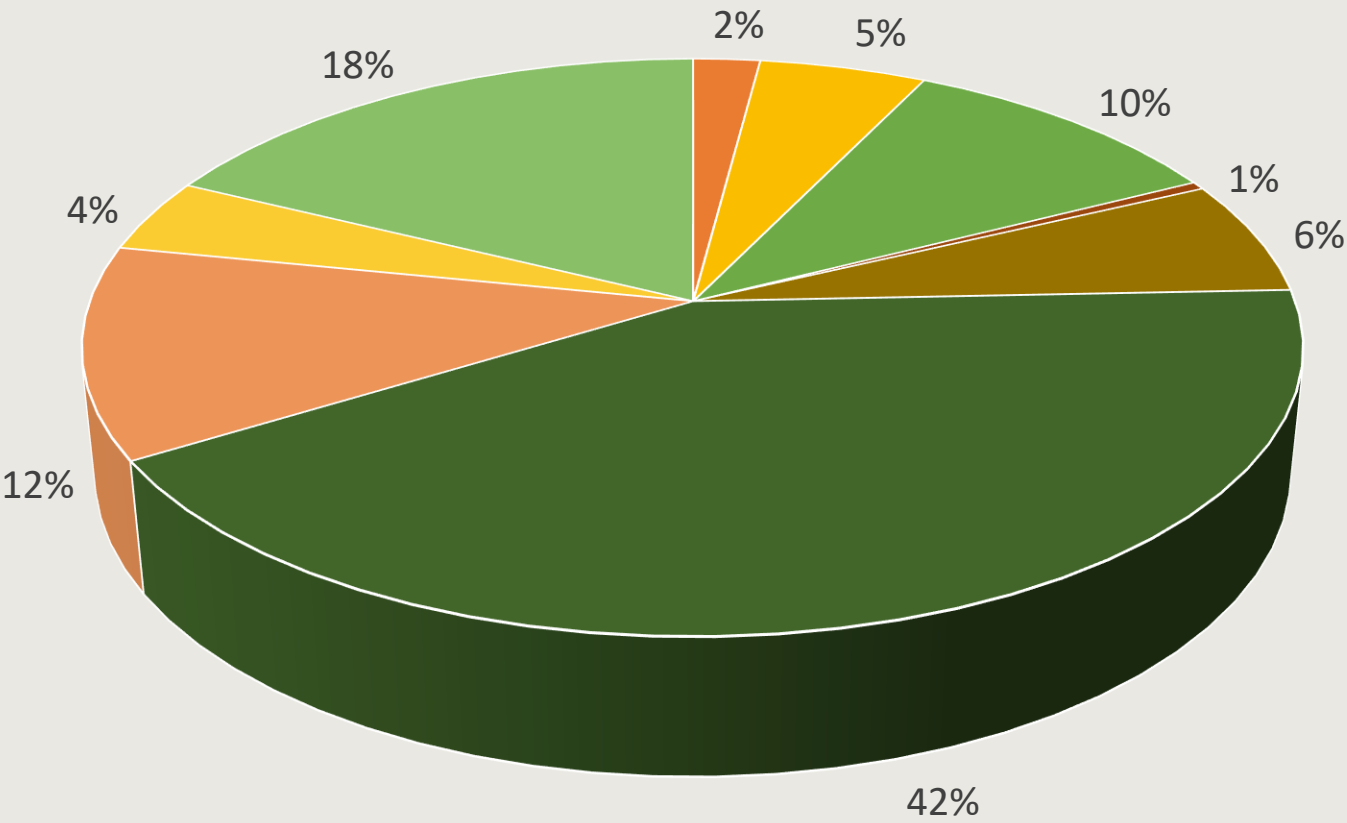
2. 3 single parent families are supported with educational and care support for their children in partnership with Promote EduHealth Restore India Forum
